Martinson & Beason recommends you print this sheet and keep a copy of it and a pen in your glove box. If you are in an accident, you may be upset and not thinking clearly. This information sheet will help you to capture all the information you need about the accident. We also recommend that you take photographs of the accident—not only the vehicles but also the surrounding area to give the context of the accident.

Accident Do's and Don't's

DO:	DON'T:
Call 911 and report the accident	Leave the accident scene
Check for injuries and treat for shock	Move injury victims
Collect driver contact and insurance information	Admit fault
Collect witness names and phone	Discuss the accident (except with the
numbers	police)
Photograph the scene, if safe to do so	Leave personal property in your car if it must be towed
Get a case number of a copy of the police report	Sign anything other than the police report
